| Christian | One who believes in Jesus Christ and follows his words and teachings |
| Jesus | He is considered by Christians to be the son of God. |
| Priest | A person who leads prayers and religious services |
| Levite | A legal expert (knows the Law). |
| Samaritan | Someone from Samaria (in Israel). |
| Neighbour | A person living next door to or very near. Christians believe our neighbours are everyone we meet |
| Enemy | One who hates or wants to harm another |

| Jesus' kindness | Christians believe Jesus could be kind to everyone because God was helping Him. They believe He is God on Earth. |
| The Good Samaritan | One of Jesus' most important teachings was 'Love your neighbour as yourself'. Jesus meant everyone is your neighbour so you should love everybody the same. |
| The story of Jesus healing the Paralysed Man | Jesus was kind to the paralysed man. He helped him walk again. This meant he could make a new start in life. |
| Christian daily life | Christians believe they should help others make the best of their lives too. People from the Salvation Army are kind because they give food to homeless people. Jesus would be proud of Christians who behave like this. |
