## Key Vocabulary and Definitions

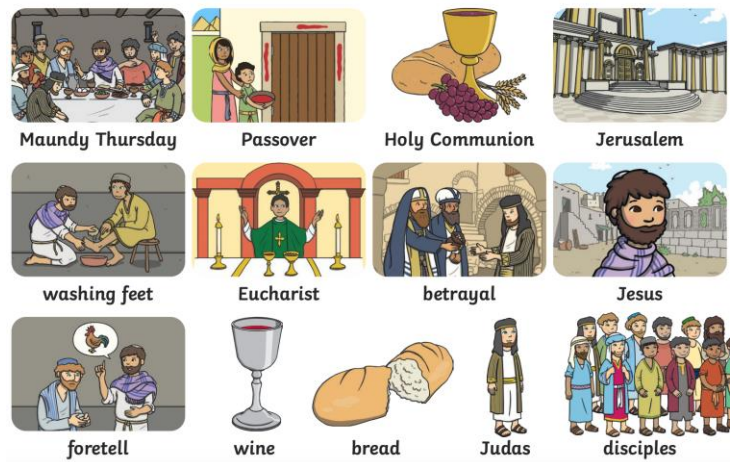
1	<b><u>Jesus</u></b>	Christians believe that Jesus was the son of God.
2	<b><u>Disciples</u></b>	The word disciple means <b>follower</b> or <b>learner</b> . In Christianity, the disciples were the students of Jesus during his teaching.
3	<b><u>The Last Supper</u></b>	The Last Supper is the final meal that, in the Gospel accounts, Jesus shared with his apostles in Jerusalem before his crucifixion.
4	<b><u>Resurrection</u></b>	For Christians, the resurrection is the belief that Jesus came back to life three days after he died on the cross.
5	<b><u>Judas and Peter</u></b>	Judas and Peter both betray Jesus in the Easter story.
6	<b><u>Forgiveness</u></b>	Forgiveness means you're letting go of feelings of anger and vengeance. You're refocusing your thoughts on positive emotions.
7	<b><u>Sin</u></b>	Sin separates humans from God, bringing lasting punishment.

## Key facts

1	Jesus' death and resurrection is a key belief for Christians.
2	Christians believe that Jesus' death was a sacrifice to offer them forgiveness for their sins and salvation.
3	Jesus death offers Christians forgiveness from God and that with his help they can do their best to forgive other people.
4	The Last Supper is the final meal that, in the Gospel accounts, Jesus shared with his apostles in Jerusalem before his crucifixion. During the meal, Jesus predicts his betrayal by one of the apostles present and foretells that before the next morning, Peter will deny knowing him three times.
5	Easter eggs are said to represent Jesus' emergence from the tomb and resurrection. The new life symbolised the egg can be seen as a metaphor for the resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday.
