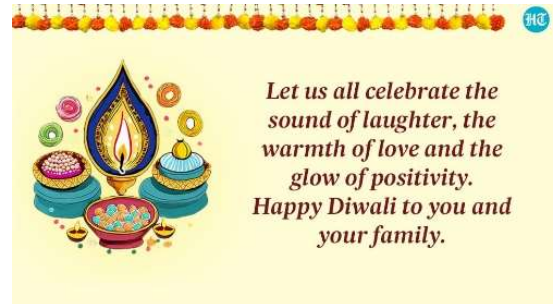

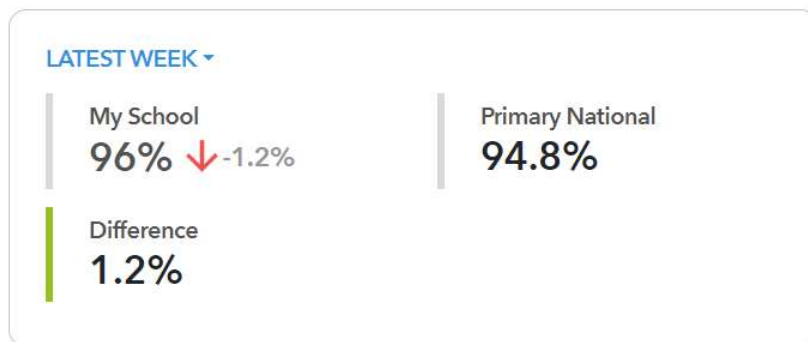
Dear Parents,

We then walked around the museum and took in various information and points of view surrounding the war. The museum is free, and may be something you may consider over half-term.

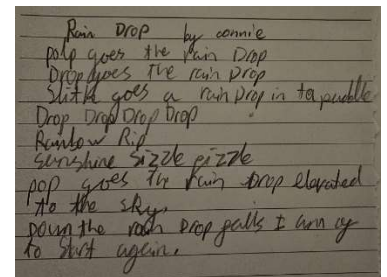




Super Work Connie (Year 5)!
