

## Dorney School Safeguarding Policy Covid-19 Appendix

During the partial closure / closure of the school we will ensure that safeguarding remains robust following the following adjustments:

### 1. DSL arrangements:

A nominated DSL will be on site each day the school is partially open.

Should all trained DSLs be in self isolation, a nominated member of SLT / MLT will be on site and the DSL will be contactable remotely.

A DSL will be available during school closure on the phone or via email.

### 2. Home learning arrangements for pupils:

Purple Mash is used to provide home learning materials. Where video tutorials/ photos are used, staff will ensure personal details are not shared.

Staff provided with guidance to support home learning and safeguarding to include professional boundaries, appropriate use of equipment to ensure safety of all.

Only staff employed by the school on the school's Single central Records will be onsite on the school's rota for onsite and working from home supporting home learning.
