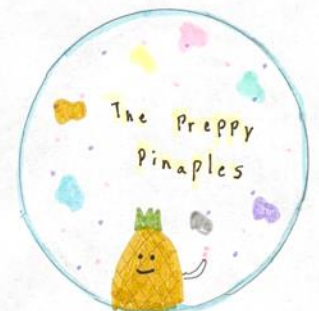
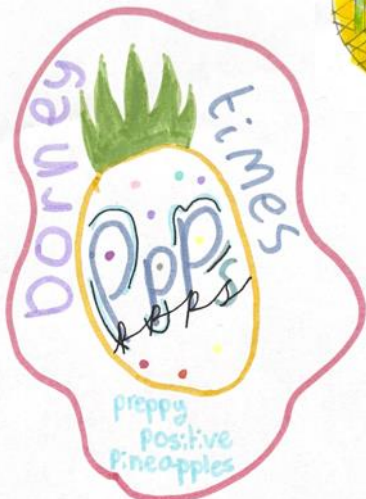

The second one said: I would like den spots

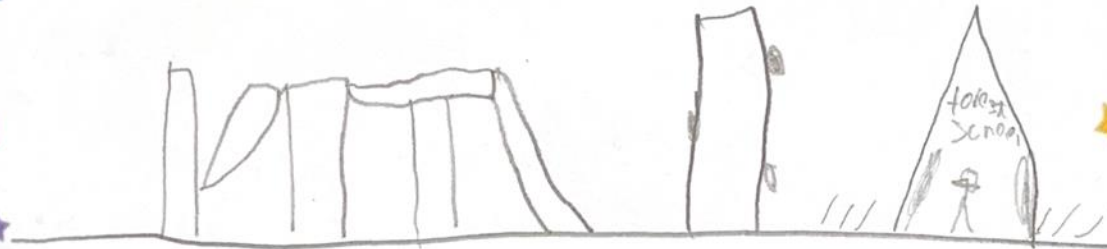
Eco council is doing a great job at looking after the greenery in the school. They made lots of lovely posters that are now displayed in the school hall. Here are three opinions about them

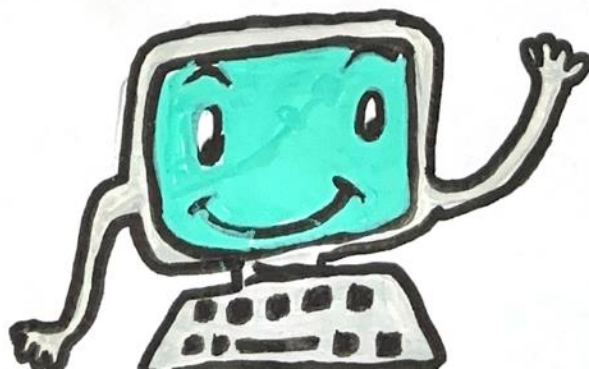
